hatching, border styles, and shapes, taking into account that some markers may overlap, such as issuing report cards on an early release day.

Tip: Using the **Format Painter** toolbar button makes it simple to copy the format from one cell or block of cells to another. For example, use the Format Painter to mark the "No School" and "Early Release" days and "Report Cards" by first selecting the cell in the legend, then clicking on the format painter button, and then the day that you want to mark.

Marking Days Using Autoshapes

The Circle for the first and last day of the year and the Triangle for the Parent teacher conferences are Autoshapes that you can use to highlight specific days.

Overwriting Formulas

You can overwrite a formula to place an "H" in place of a holiday for example. Be very careful if you copy/paste days so that you don't mess up the formulas. You can copy/paste the formulas for the days *within* the same month, but *not between* months.

Background Colors

The background color of the weekends and blank days are controlled using conditional formatting (Format > Conditional Formatting)

New Color Schemes: To load a different color scheme, open one of the accompanying blank calendar workbooks, then return to this workbook and go to Tools > Options > Color Tab, and select the other workbook from the "Copy Colors From" drop-down box.

To quickly create a new color scheme, download Excel Calendar PRO or the free Excel Calendar Template from Vertex42.com to create new color schemes and copy the colors using the technique described above.

If you make a PDF of the calendar, it must have "Created using a free template from vertex42.com" or a similar notice to that effect somewhere on the page (usually in the footer). If you want to post a calendar that has been created specifically for your school on a website in PDF format, you may do so as long as the above reference is included on the PDF (usually in the footer) and a link is placed on your website pointing to the original download page, using the following URL:
